Regional Preparations

1) Transportation

- State budget \$162.4 million for improvements
- Efforts focused on Meade and Hardin counties (from where a majority of workforce commutes)

2) Infrastructure

- State budget \$88.5 million to begin improvements
 - Schools
 - Water / Sewer



-Infrastructure Needs- State of Kentucky \$100 million appropriation for 2009-2010

- \$50 million for water, wastewater, and education initiatives.
- \$50 million for road projects; to include planning, design & right-of-way acquisitions.

appropriation for 2011-2012**

Transportation: Road Construction Needs

- Extend KY 313 from KY 1500 in Vine Grove to US 60 in Meade County
- Construct new route from Elizabethtown Bypass to KY 313 in Radcliff
- Construct new connector from Veteran's Parkway (KY 1646) in Radcliff to KY 313 in Vine Grove
- North Wilson Road Improvements – From W. Lincoln Trail Blvd. to 31W overpass



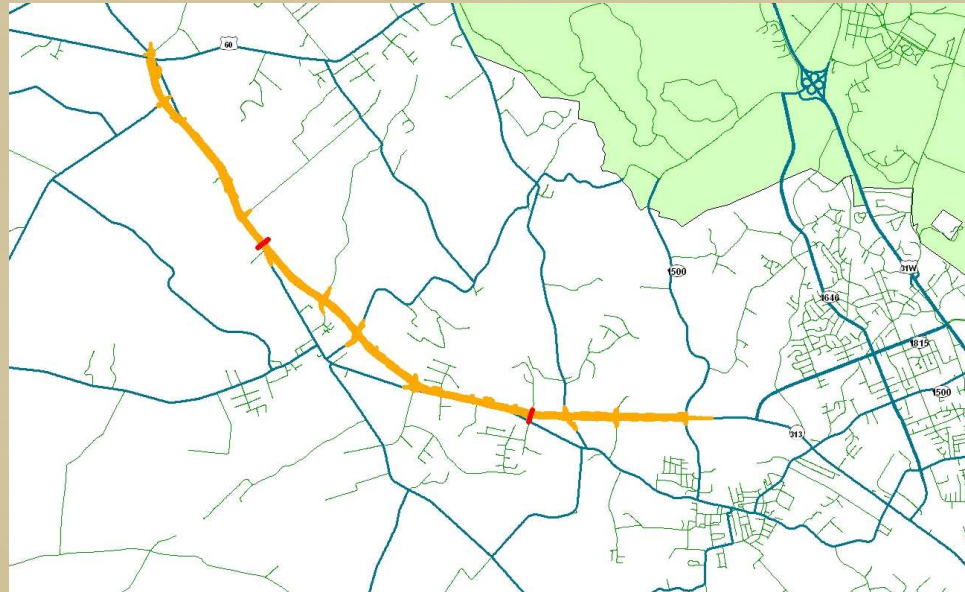

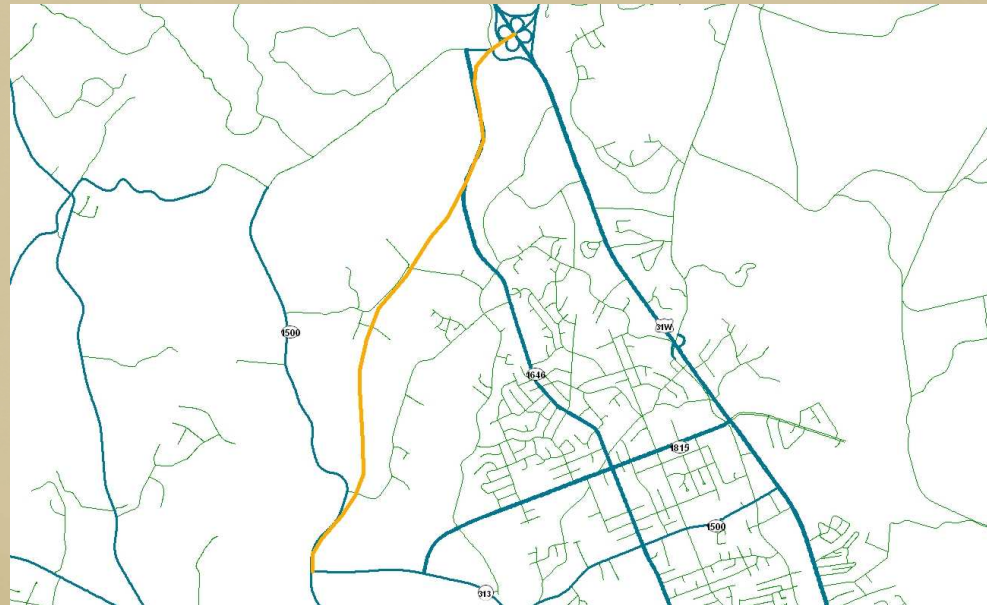
